Uniform Policy

Appearance Regulations

The wearing of full school uniform is expected as an integral part of the school ethos which promotes positive attitudes, high standards and a sense of personal pride.

Students are expected to look neat and tidy at all times. Uniform should be clean and repaired or replaced if necessary; we welcome parental support in ensuring that students adhere to this expectation.

Stretford High School has a zero tolerance to defiance of the school's uniform policy.

Hairstyles

Fashions evolve over time and we remain aware of changes in trends, however:

Extreme hairstyles are not permitted. The school is the arbiter of what is considered "extreme".

If in doubt please contact the school.

- A haircut shorter than a number 2 is not permitted.
- Shaven or totally plucked eyebrows are not acceptable.
- Hair should be clean, well brushed, neat and of a natural colour.
- Hair which has been dyed is not acceptable.
- Styles where lines and or shapes are cut into hair are not acceptable
- Hair extensions are unsuitable for school; students with hair extensions will be asked to remove them.
- Beads and other fashion hair accessories are not allowed.
- Students may wear a plain black headband.
- Students may wear plain black/grey headscarf/turban; no other colours are allowed.
- Students who fail to follow the appearance regulations of the school may be placed in Isolation.

Make-up

Face make-up is not allowed.

Nail varnish and fake nails are not allowed. Students will be asked to remove these.

Fake tan is not allowed.

Students wearing make-up will be asked to remove it;

Visible tattoos are not acceptable – this includes eyebrow tattoos and lines or shapes cut into eyebrows.

Jewellery

Earrings – one small plain pair of studs, of a maximum diameter of 3mm, can be worn in the ear lobe only. Earrings are to be removed for PE.

No other piercings are allowed. Students will be asked to remove these.

One plain finger ring will be allowed.

Plain wrist watch will be allowed.

- Plain black/grey head scarf/turban

- Plain black school shoes.

The items marked with an * are essential and the minimum required for students to purchase.

All items of clothing must be named**Standard School Skirt**

School skirts are to be black or grey – tight fitting designs are not allowed

Skirts must be regulation length – knee length.

Skirts must not be rolled up at the waist.

Trousers

Students will only be permitted to wear the standard back or grey school trousers.

Chinos, lycra, cling style trousers or black skinny trousers are not allowed.

Legging are not allowed

Jeans are not allowed

Trousers should sit on the waist.

Shirts/ties

A white school shirt and a school tie are compulsory for all students.

The top button of shirts must be fastened and the tie must cover the top button.

Students are expected to wear their shirts tucked into trousers/skirts.

Only plain white t-shirt vests/underwear may be worn under school shirts; these must not be visible at the collar of the shirt. Students wearing coloured t-shirts will be asked to remove them.

School Blazer

This is compulsory for all students.

Blazers should be clean and tidy and in good repair.

All students are expected to wear their blazers as they come into school in the morning and as they leave school at the end of the day.

School Jumper

A school jumper is optional – a V-neck grey jumper with double stripe. This is only available from our uniform suppliers.

Blazers MUST be worn over the jumper.

The jumper must not be tucked in to waistbands.

The school jumper does NOT replace the blazer.

Outdoor Coats/Jackets/Scarves

Outdoor coats/jackets/scarves/gloves must not be worn inside the school buildings or in the classroom.

Students must not wear hats, scarves or gloves in school buildings.

Sweatshirts or hooded tops of any description are not permitted to be worn on the school site, below or on top of blazers.

Baseball caps are not allowed.

Footwear

Shoes

Sensible plain, all black leather shoes should be worn for school. Logos, labels or sport branding are not permitted.

Boots, trainers, canvas, open toe, designer or high heels are not allowed for school.

Trainer type shoes are not allowed.

Shoes with white / coloured soles or stripes are not allowed.

Students who arrive into school wearing trainers or other unsuitable footwear may be sent home to change; they will be expected to make up missed lesson time after school.

Please consult the school website for further information. If in doubt, contact the school.

Socks

Only plain, black, grey or white socks are allowed.

Tights must be plain black, patterned tights are not allowed.

Students may not wear socks over tights.

Socks must be ankle or knee length; above the knee socks or trainer socks are not suitable for school.

Leg warmers and leggings are not allowed.

Students are expected to take personal responsibility for their belongings. The school cannot take responsibility for personal items that are lost.

Aerosols, including deodorants, are not allowed in school; these will be confiscated.
